Here is the booking information anyway: To enter this show you must book in on-line beforehand – unless you want to line up and buy a ticket at the gate with everybody else on the day. Tickets at the gate cost \$60 per day. Booking in allows you to put your car on display and entry for one (1) driver to the show.

To enter your car, go to *Wings Over Illawarra 2020* web site, then click on the pull down menu titled GET INVOLVED. This gives an option - see CLASSIC CAR REGISTRATION. At the end of the information is the registration form which you fill in on-line. We have been listed under 'Morris Minor CC of NSW' – and you can't enter without belonging to a Club!
